For the past 10 years, our population has grown at an average annual rate of 3.4%, making Spruce Grove one of the fastest-growing mid-size cities in western Canada.



Make a splash!



Let your pup run free through nine acres of fully fenced grass at the Cpl. Jim Galloway Memorial Off Leash Area – with a separate fenced section for small dogs. Or, for the more adventurous, there's the unfenced Marlboro Off-Leash Park located near Heritage Grove Park.

Excellent schools – from K-12 and beyond

Spruce Grove is home to many K-12 public schools, along with education alternatives like separate (Catholic), private schools and French immersion programs.

Health, wellness and peace of mind

Integrated, protective services

By integrating our local RCMP detachment with our community peace officers, and combining fire with emergency medical services (EMS), the City of Spruce Grove has created a holistic safety net to protect residents and businesses 24/7.

The expansion of Spruce Grove's Protective Services Facility creates a state-of-the-art facility that provides extra space for administrative offices, equipment bays, dormitories and training areas.

Integrated RCMP Facility

Our 53,000 sq/ft RCMP facility is the home of regional collaboration with the City of Stony Plain, housing municipal and provincial RCMP, support personnel and a traffic unit.

Safe City

The Safe City initiative is our framework for keeping public spaces safe for all residents. By linking residents, businesses, schools, health care agencies, community groups and others with protective services programs, Spruce Grove promotes personal and community safety.

Accessible, professional health and wellness services

Queen Street Medical Centre is an 80,000 sq/ft multi-tenant complex featuring family medical clinics, and support-service tenants, including pharmacy, laboratory and diagnostic services.

Copper Sky Lodge is a supportive living facility merging the concepts of independent living and 24-hour support. Committed to providing the highest quality of care, Copper Sky offers a charming home environment while assisting with activities of daily living.

Westwind Centre features a full-service family medical clinic and pharmacy, as well as other health and wellness services, including medical aesthetics, laser services, massage therapy, physiotherapy, psychology, acupuncture and holistic nutrition.

Located minutes west of Spruce Grove, in Stony Plain, the WestView Health Centre offers full-service hospital care.

Close to major, full-service hospitals in Edmonton like Misericordia Hospital, the University of Alberta and the Stollery Children's Hospitals.
