# Update on Myshak Metro Ballpark and New Team Name









The Spruce Gold Partnership has announced the name of their ball team that will be playing out of the <a href="Myshak Metro Ballpark">Myshak Metro Ballpark</a>! The new team name, announced on March 3, is <a href="Energy City Cactus Rats">Energy City Cactus Rats</a>. This name emerged from a community-driven process where residents submitted ideas and voted on their favorites.

Construction of the Myshak Metro Ballpark, valued at \$32 million, is on track for opening in June 2025. The ballpark is located at 2000 McLeod Avenue at the northeast corner of Pioneer Road and Highway 16A.

As the weather improves, work will begin on the third suite level, the concourse concrete, distinctive mass timber architectural elements, artificial turf and grass outfield, and service buildings such as concessions and washrooms. The developer of the ballpark project is Spruce Gold Partnership.

The Spruce Gold Partnership envisions this venue as more than just a baseball stadium. It will be a community hub and event facility able to host outdoor concerts, corporate and community events, watch parties, weddings, dog and car shows, special markets, and more.
