EconoLube Expands Legacy in Spruce Grove









<u>EconoLube</u>, a fixture in Spruce Grove for 34 years, is adding a significant expansion project to their east facility on #8 120 St Matthews Avenue. The expansion, slated for completion by late April and open to the public in May, includes an additional 3,680

square feet. In addition, they are renovating 1,900 square feet dedicated to a spacious waiting area and service counter.

The expansion and renovation aim to enhance the customer experience, with the five state-of-the-art mechanical repair bays equipped with the latest technology and an inhouse alignment rack. With a staff of 24, 90% of whom are based in Spruce Grove, EconoLube ensures uninterrupted service during the transition, operating temporarily from a third location.

EconoLube has evolved into a full-service automotive shop, providing drive-through maintenance, complete automotive repair, tire services, and ADAS service previously exclusive to dealerships.

This development not only modernizes EconoLube's facilities but also reaffirms its status as a cornerstone of the community.


