

SPRUCE GROVE CIVIC CENTRE - CONSTRUCTION UPDATE









The new Spruce Grove <u>Civic Centre</u> is taking shape! Located at 50 Westwind Drive, the Civic Centre will be the single largest project the City has ever done at \$77.8M. Amenities include a spectator arena, community arena, a satellite location for the Spruce Grove Public Library, a black box theatre, art gallery, and a community walking track.

Construction is proceeding on schedule! The structural steel and roof of the community arena are nearing completion. The forming and beams for the spectator arena seating bowl are well underway, with the structural steel anticipated to be complete by end of January 2024.

Underground plumbing for the dressing rooms is in place and the concrete floors are being poured. Interior finishes will begin in May 2024. The projected construction completion is late November 2024 with the facility opening to the public in the first quarter 2025. This is a LEED certified facility with accommodations to allow for solar panels in the future.

Fun Facts

- The City of Spruce Grove and the Spruce Grove Saints have recently <u>reached an</u> <u>agreement</u> in principle for the Junior "A" hockey club to remain in Spruce Grove and play out of the Spectator Arena
- As at the end of November, 64,884 person hours of work on site with 358 tons of construction waste material was recycled and diverted from the land fill
- The site hosted post secondary engineering and trades students, allowing our future trades people to experience the construction site firsthand
